At the conclusion of the fair, I will provide a thank you card/letter to the buyer of my project following its sale, as well as a thank you card/letter to the owner of the farm at which I house my project. My FFA Advisor will also provide me with any needed advisement and assistance throughout my project.


Time Investment

My daily responsibilities will include feeding and watering my animal, as well as cleaning out their pen and disposing of manure and bedding properly. I will attend all meetings and showmanship practices as assigned by my FFA Advisor, unless I have good cause and speak to them prior about missing. I will also work with my animal on my own time in preparation for the Santa Barbara County Fair.


Financial Investment

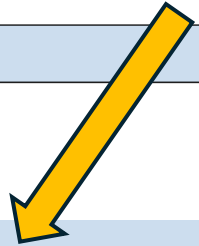
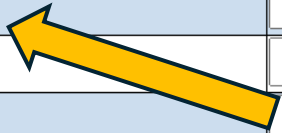
